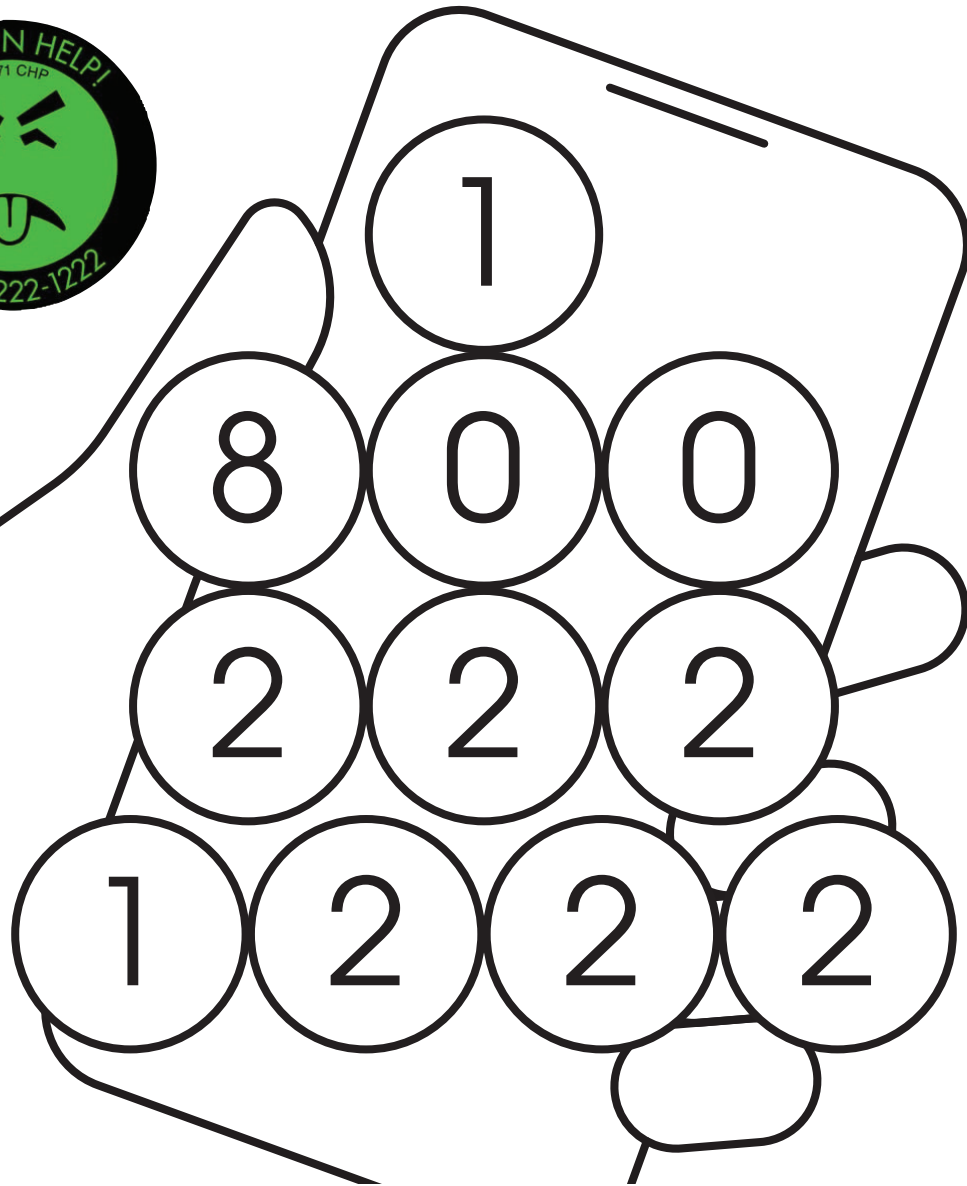

In case of a suspected poisoning

If you suspect that a child may have gotten into an item that is unsafe, ALWAYS:

- Take the child away from the item or room.
- Try to see what the product is.

After the emergency actions, call 1-800-222-1222.

Interpreters able to help all non-English-speaking callers.



Play it safe.

Ask a grown-up who loves you before touching, tasting or smelling an unknown item. Grown-ups help you to stay safe from poisons.



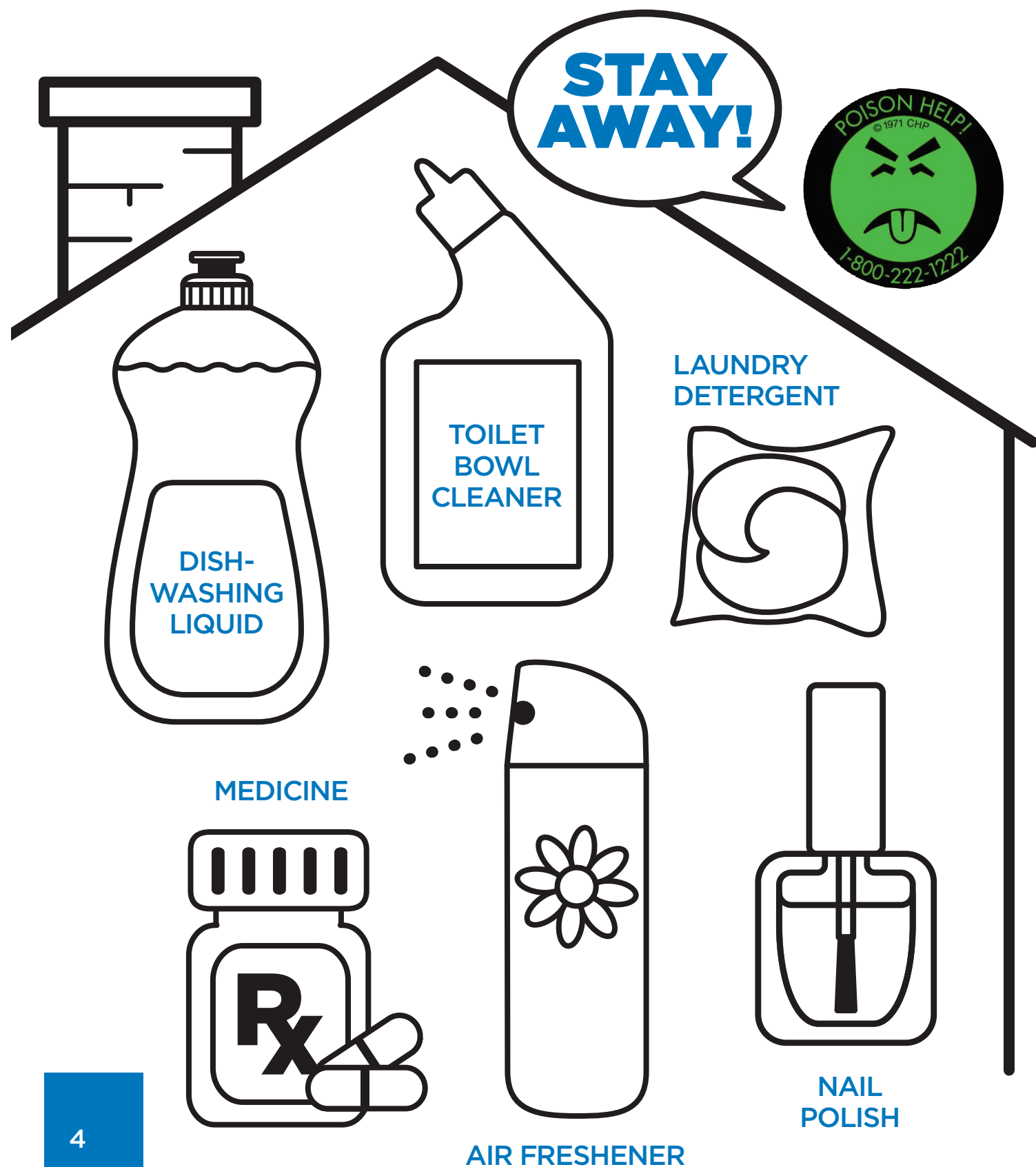
Be smart about poisons.

Poisons are everywhere!

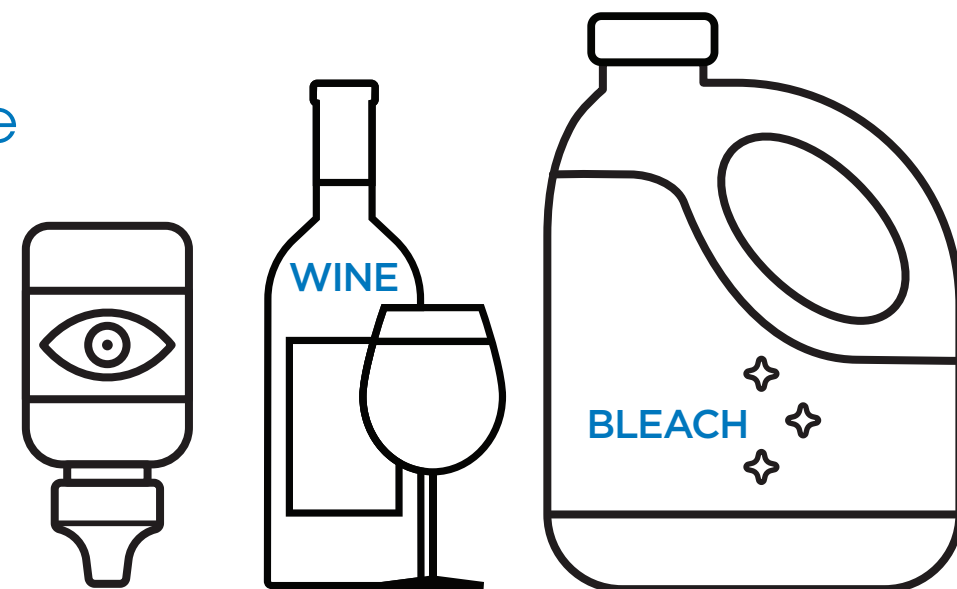

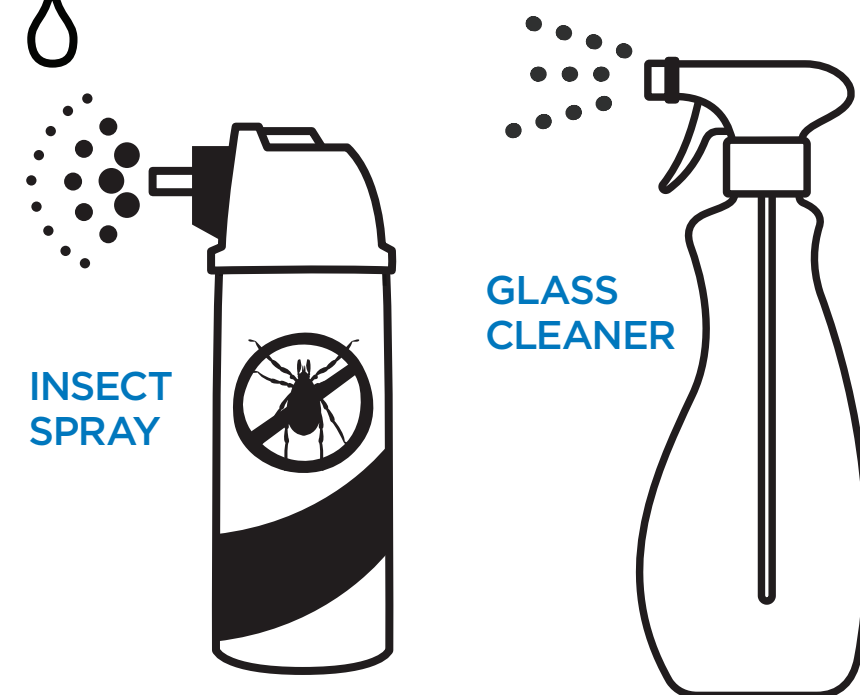

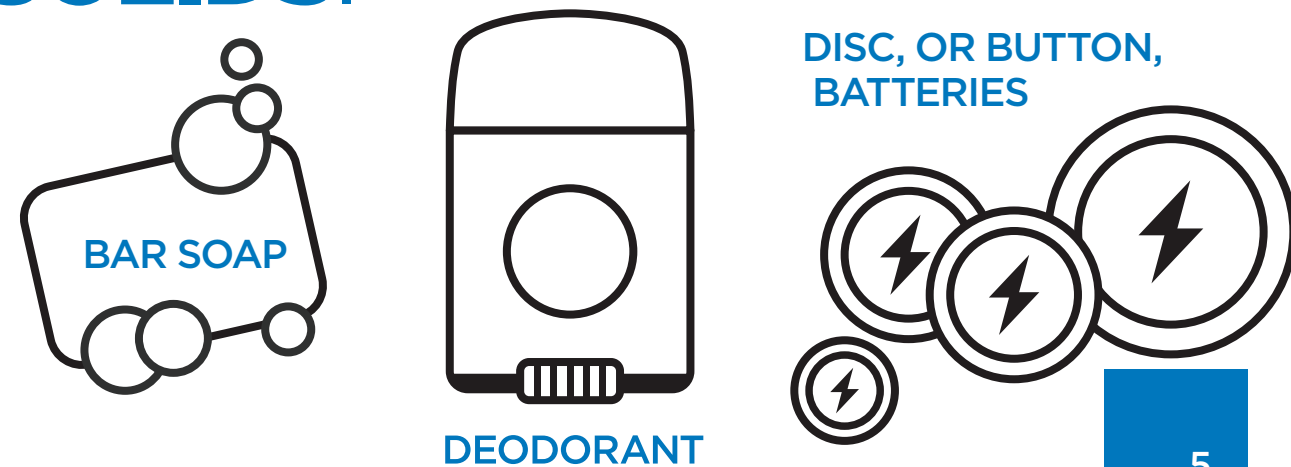
EYE DROPS



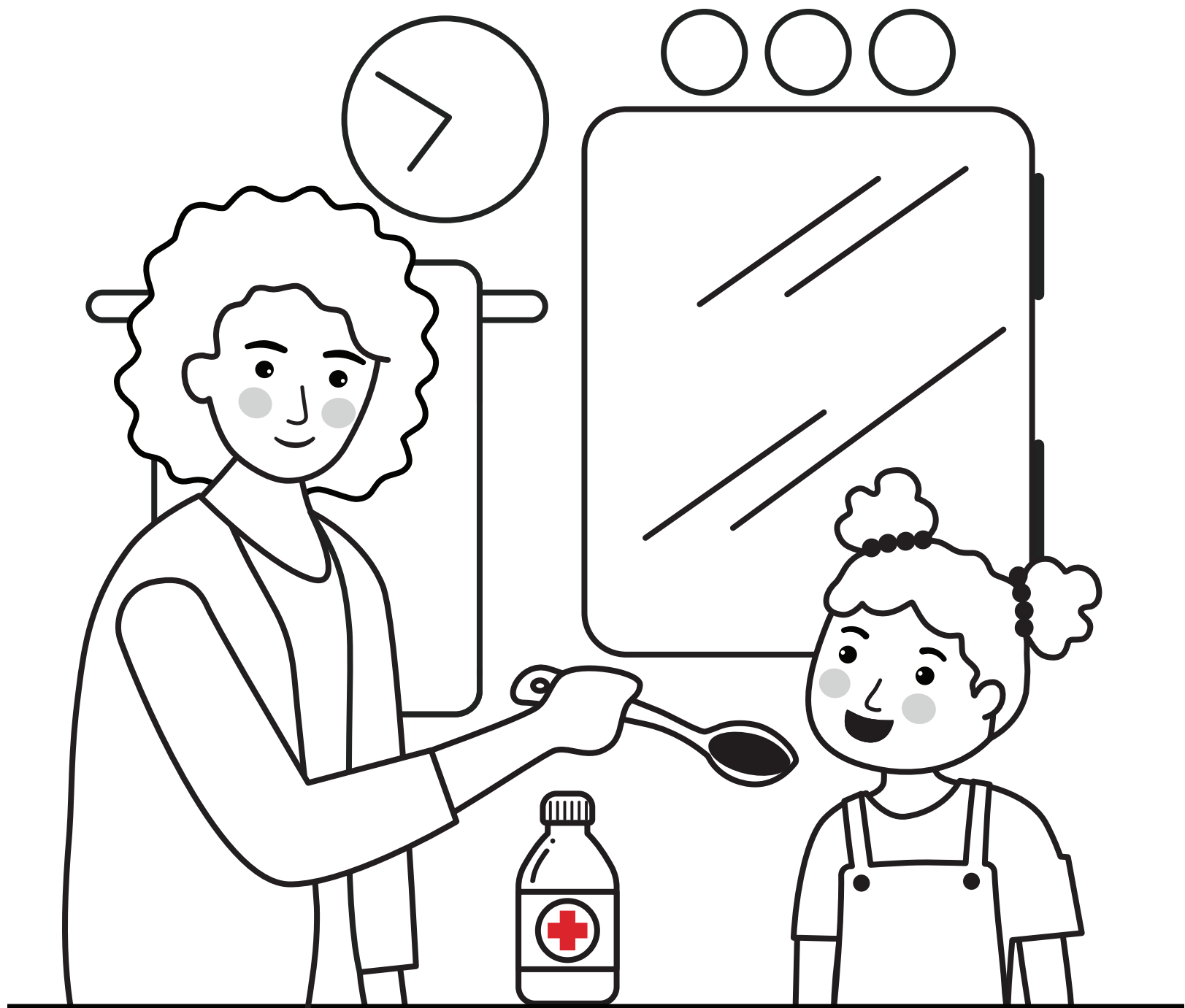
SPRAYS

All medicines and vitamins should be in locked cabinets. Only take medicine from a grown-up who loves you.

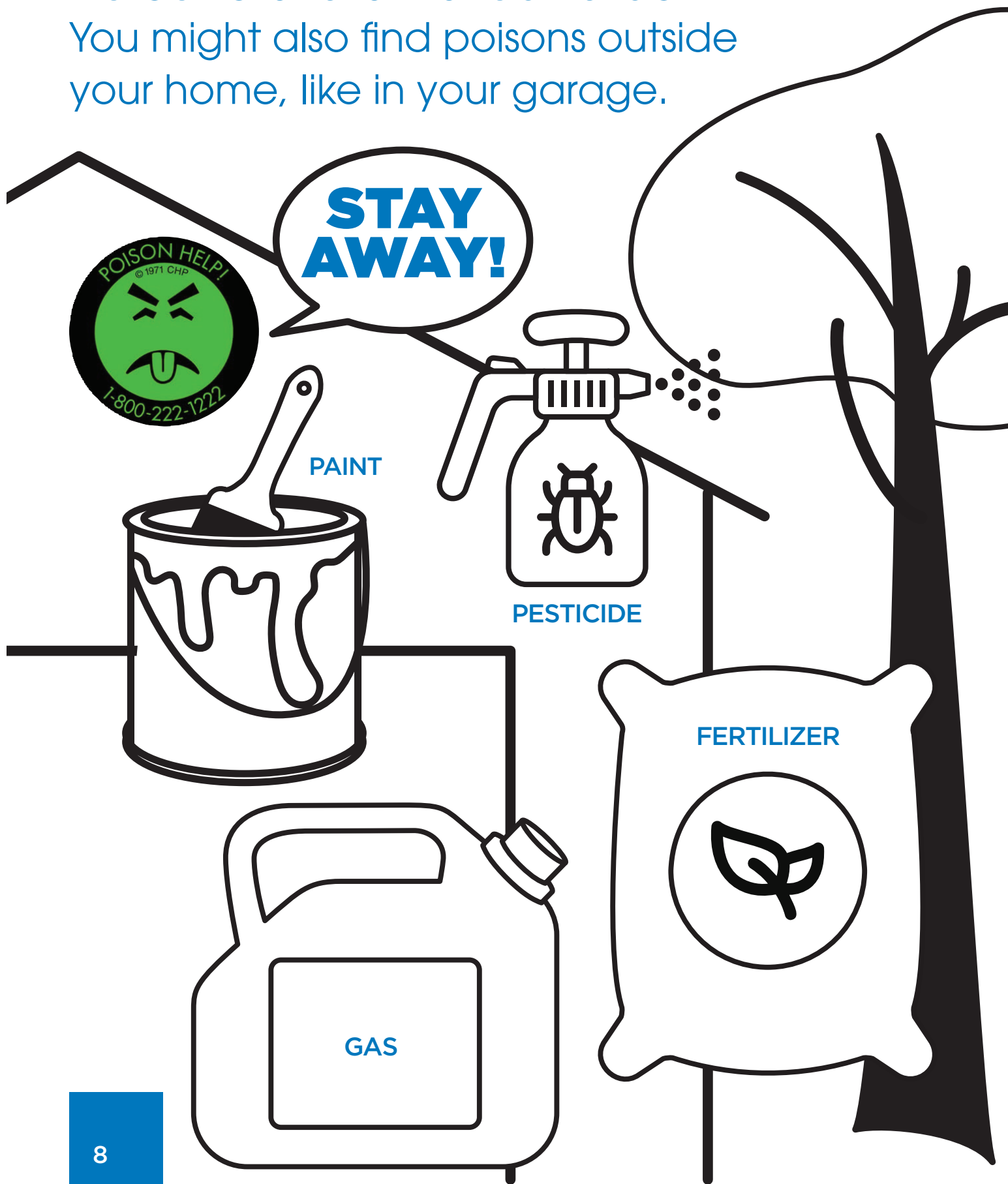


Smoking, drinking alcohol and taking pills are NOT for kids. **They will make you sick.**

You might also find poisons outside your home, like in your garage.



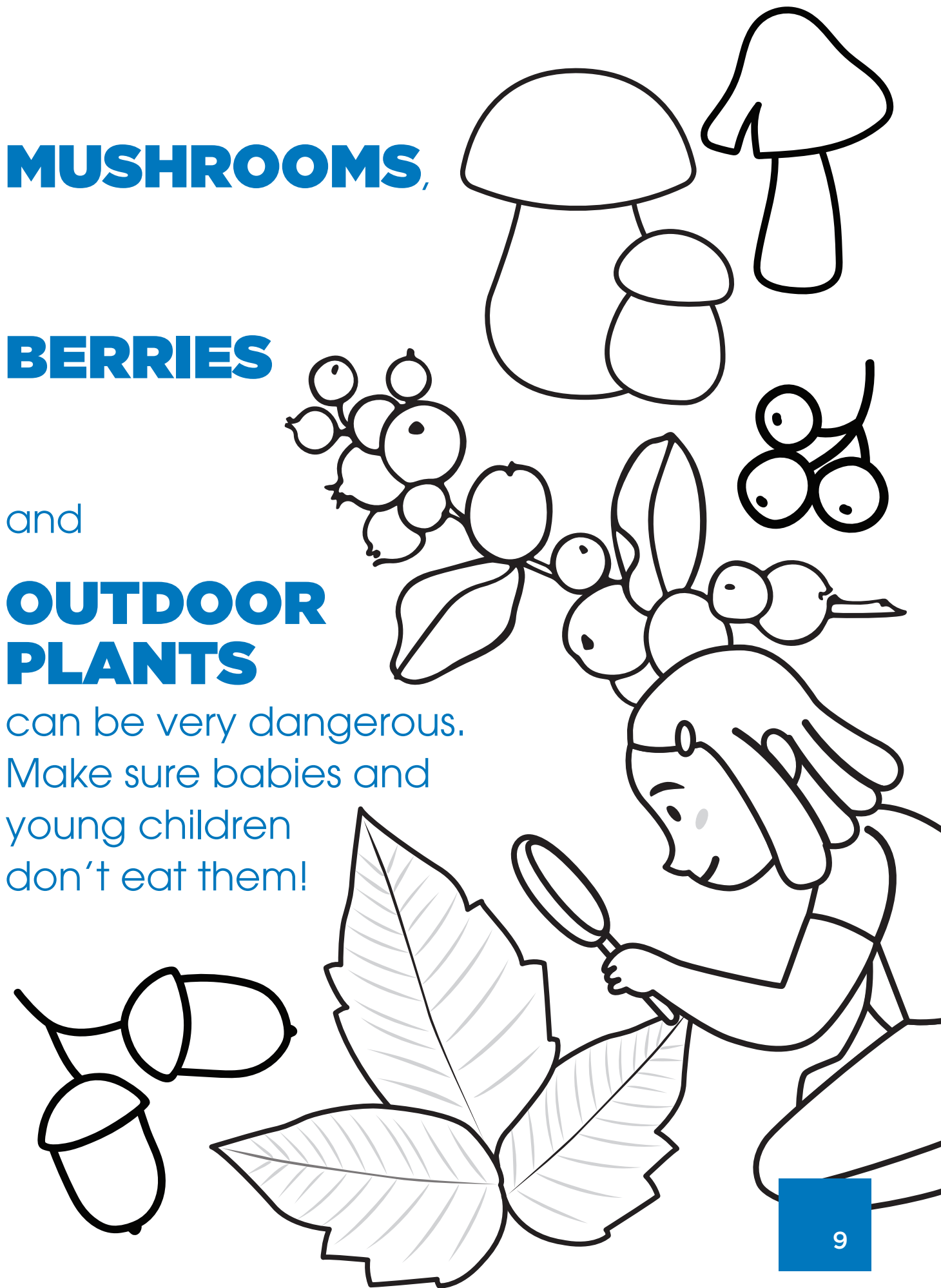
MUSHROOMS,
