Public Support Systems Available to Assist You and Your Child - Participants will learn about agencies that can provide services and supports for your family, including Birth to 3, the Family Support Program, respite and other county based programs and what to do when services are not immediately available.

More About Medicaid - Participants will learn more about Medicaid benefits and how to get what you need for your child. We will discuss Children's Long Term Support Waivers, HealthCheck and Medicaid card services as well as prior authorizations and denials.
