To get to Children’s Hospital of Wisconsin:

Take Watertown Plank Rd. to 92nd St.
Turn South onto 92nd St.

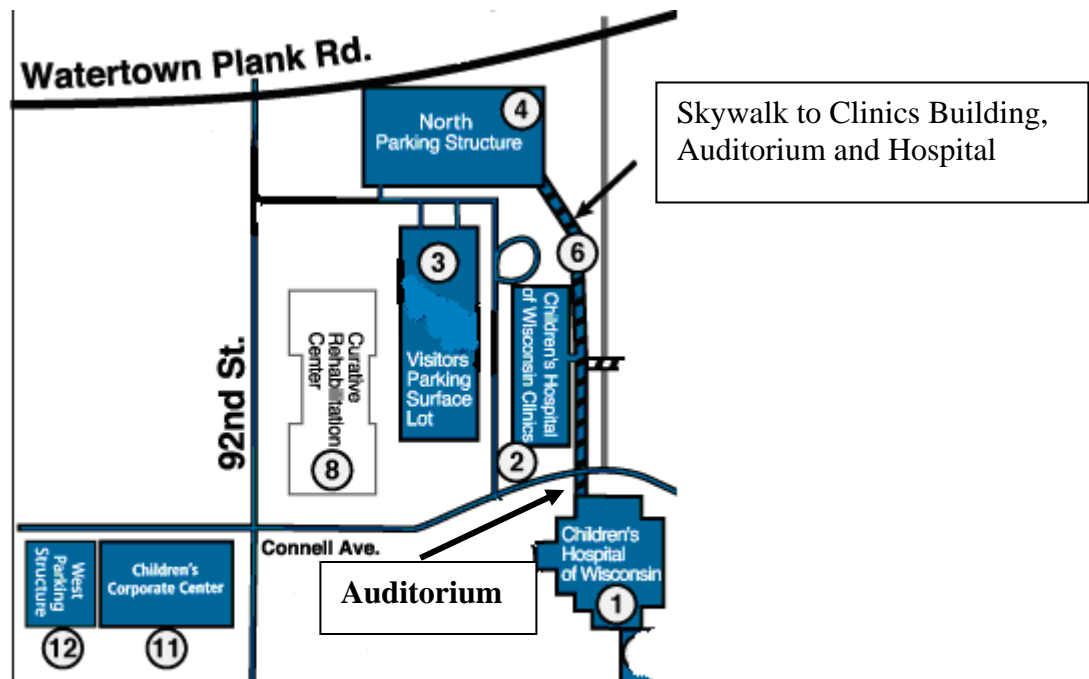
OR

Take Wisconsin Avenue to 92nd St.
Turn North onto 92nd St.

THEN:

Turn East onto Connell Avenue
Follow along Connell and enter into the North Parking Structure

Come through the entrance on the second floor of the North parking structure (4). Take the skywalk past the Clinics Building (6). Just as you exit the skywalk, the auditorium is to the right. Follow the signs. If you come through the Clinics Building (2) main entrance on the first floor, take the elevator to the second floor, go to the skywalk and follow the signs to the auditorium.
